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Fees

All entry fees, food and activity costs are covered by the participant, costs for this program are listed above. We provide service to people who have NDIS funding. Staffing costs are billed separately, in line with the NDIS price guide for flexible Core Supports. All activities that utilise activity-based transport will incur an additional charge of \$7.50 payable through NDIS funding, although if insufficient NDIS funds this may be billed privately (plus GST).

What to Bring

- Your personal money (cash or card) to make purchase
- Medication if required to take medication during the activity.

Special Requirements

Please advise if the participant has any specific dietary requirements including any concerns with the consumption of alcohol e.g. not to consume due to contraindications with prescribed medication.
